Each year *Little Things Mean a Lot* is the Swan Coach House Gallery's most eagerly anticipated exhibition. From the year 2000, when it was just a Small Sketches show, it has evolved into a multimedia extravaganza of small works of art encompassing a broad range of art and artists. Wonderful artwork from every medium including: painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, printmaking, collage, fiber, and ceramics now cover the walls of our gallery. The work of talented emerging artists hangs next to the work of prominent established artists, most of them from the Atlanta area.

What has also evolved is our practice of selling art outright and replacing it with new pieces, usually by the same artist whose work has sold. For that reason, the show is constantly evolving, and may change from week to week. The size of the show has evolved over the years from just 100 works of art to well over 300 pieces. Because of the exhibition's popularity, we now rotate the artists, and invite a different group to participate each year.

There is something magical about things made small, especially at this time of year. We hope you will enjoy seeing as well as purchasing these delightful works of art and learn for yourself why little things mean a lot.
