The Swan Coach House can accommodate 20 to 200 guests for afternoon tea. Afternoon teas are held in a series of beautifully decorated rooms or on the first and second floors, flowing into a gracefully landscaped garden. All three levels of our facility would be utilized for groups larger than 100. Tenting is available for our back garden area if necessary. The use of our beautiful, antique tea cups and teapots is included.

Our normal business hours are Monday through Saturday from 11:00 am to 2:30 pm. Generally our afternoon teas last two hours and begin at 2pm. The fees are based on the size of your group and the day of the week that you would like to hold your event.

AFTERNOON TEA FEES

For 20-40 guests during normal business hours *(before 4pm)*, there is a \$200 rental fee for use of one of our private rooms for two hours.

For 20-40 guests for a late afternoon tea *(after 4pm)*, there is a \$600 rental fee for use of one of our private rooms for a two hour time frame.

For 40-200 guests for a late afternoon tea, there is a \$900 rental fee and full use of our facility for a two hour time frame.

To host a tea on Sunday, there is a facility rental of \$1,000. This includes full use of our facility for two hours.

Please note that a valet is required for groups of 40 or more, and that valets are not included for Teas taking place after 4pm. There is a \$150 charge per valet attendant.
